

Target Audience

This curriculum is designed for the TB professional who is responsible for training staff, health care workers and non-medical people on basic tuberculosis information.

Conference Goal

The goal of this training is to enhance the expertise of the local TB health care trainer so they can effectively organize a training and teach others introductory information on TB infection, treatment and care.

Conference Objectives

Using interactive lectures and case studies participants will be able to teach to others the basic information on: epidemiology of TB; transmission and pathogenesis; testing and diagnosis of TB infection and disease; treatment for latent TB infection and TB disease; infection control; basic contact investigation principles; and reporting of TB. Attendees will also be able to effectively set up a training and understand the principles that govern adult learning techniques.

Format

The format for this course will include lectures and audience participation through the teach back method. Each attendee will be required to "teach" the group and receive feedback on the skills they have learned. There will be ample time for questions and answers.
