# Challenges

#### Issues with medications being available when needed

- Not having shorter course medications available to treat LTBI patients.
- Reserving Rifampin for disease cases.

# Staff turnover and other competing priorities at the Local Public Health Agencies (LPHAs)

- Loss of TB knowledge and experience.
- Training new LPHA staff during COVID.
- Increase in demand for State TB Elimination Program Staff.
