Identifying a Pediatric Patient

- Diagnosis
 - Contact, LTBI, possible TB disease, active TB disease
- Initial contact
- Parental apprehension
- Education
- Planning



Treatment Barriers


- Administering medicine/DOT
- Length of treatment
- School and activities
- Adverse reactions



Baby “A”

- Background
 - 18 mo/o female contact to 4+, INH resistant, active TB
 - Negative skin test with PCP before contacted by the health department

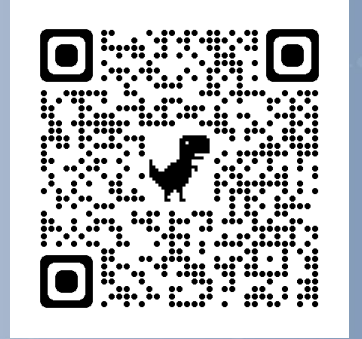
Dear Chelsea,
