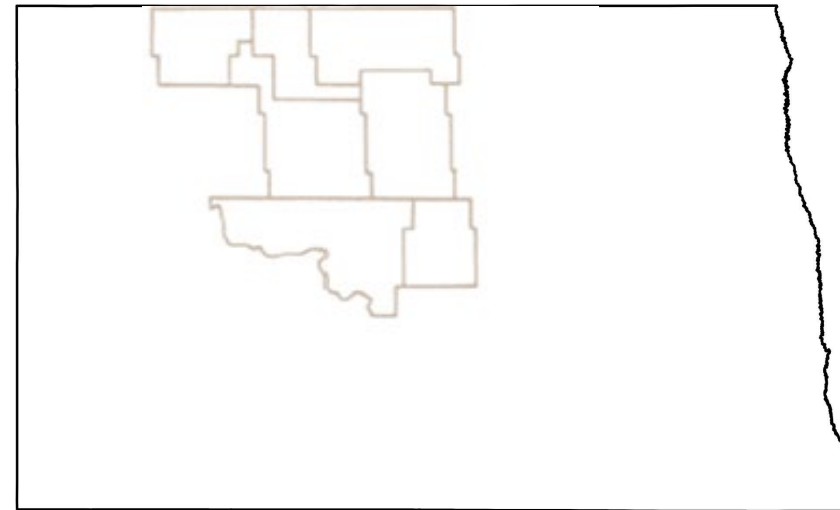

NURSE ROLL

As the TB case manager for FDHU my rolls are:

- Following up with LTBI cases monthly until they are completed with their medication regimens.
- Provide DOT therapy if needed
- Provide IRGA testing
- Refer anyone who has a positive IGRA test
- Provide TST's to inmates that have been incarcerated for 14 days or longer at the jail
- I provide guidance and assistance to the county nurses if there is an active or latent TB case in their county.

CHALLENGES

- With ND being a rural state, it can be difficult to get patients their treatment, testing supplies, and getting them to their appointments.
- Sometimes you may travel over an hour to see a patient.
- Winters can make travel more difficult at times.

ADDRESSING CHALLENGES

- Depending which county nurse is closest, we work together to accommodate each patient's needs. Such as picking up sputum cultures and delivering medications.
