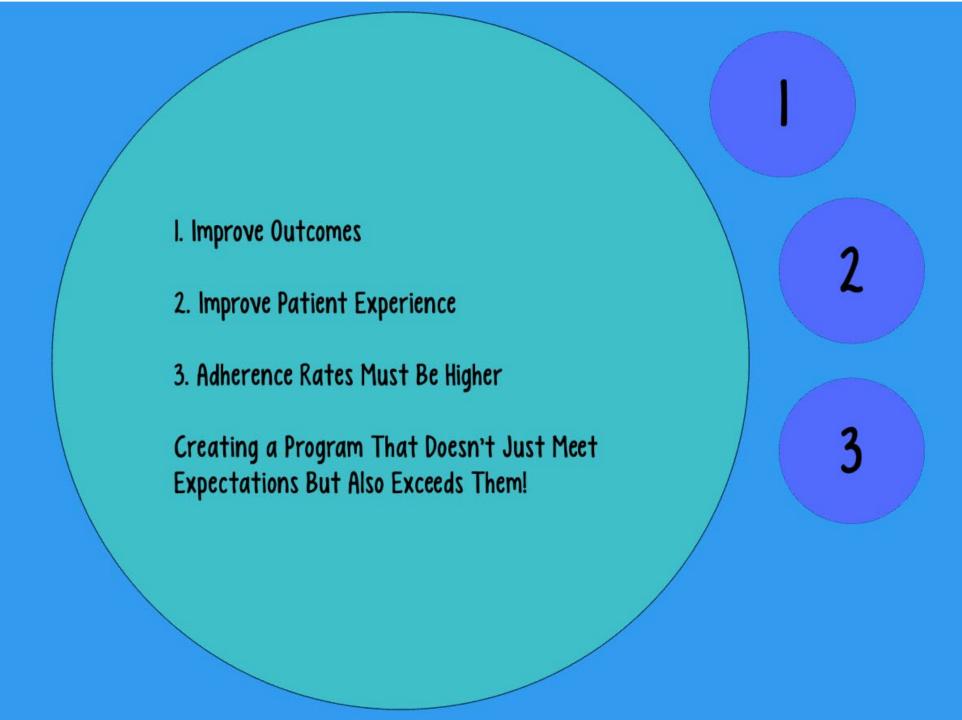
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# **TB Treatment Completion** Rates Should Be Higher

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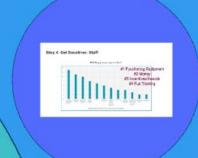

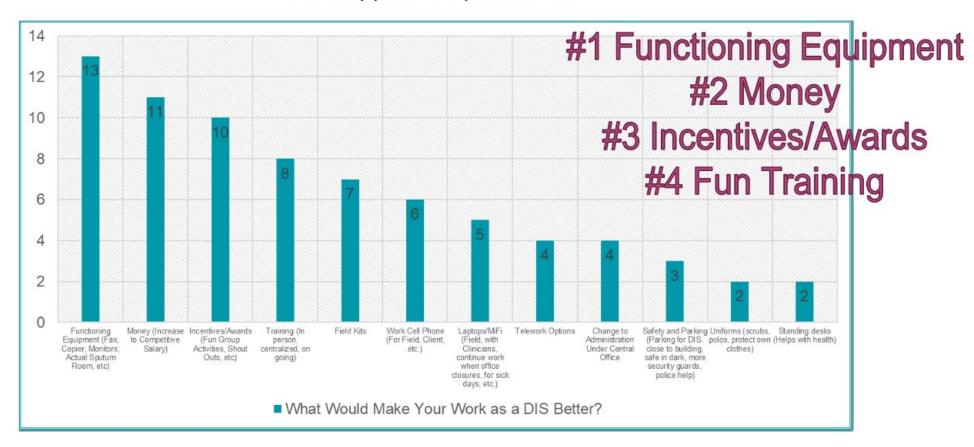

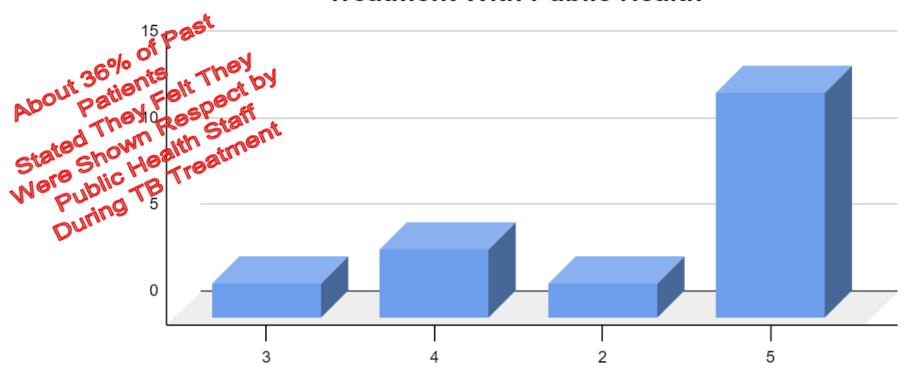
#### **DIS Happiness Opinion Poll**
