TARGET AUDIENCE

This course is intended for physicians, nurse practitioners, and registered nurses with experience in the management of patients with, or at risk of TB within the state of Texas. This is not an introductory course. It is required for nursing participants to have a minimum of one year experience in TB case management and to have attended one of the TB Nurse Case Management courses prior to attending TB Intensive.

COURSE GOAL

The goal of this course is to obtain advanced knowledge on clinical updates in TB, engage with private providers, and discuss ethical considerations in providing patient-centered care in order to improve their practice for the management and care of patients living with TB.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the completion of this training participants will be able to 1) describe current recommendations and updates in the treatment and diagnosis of TB disease and LTBI, 2) identify at least two lab related technologies to assist in the treatment and control of TB, 3) identify at least two diagnostic related technologies to assist in the treatment and prevention of TB, 4) discuss three treatment strategies in treating special populations and/or high-risk patients, 5) discuss ethical considerations within management of patients with TB, and 6) use case studies to examine challenges with TB treatment and treatment completion.

COURSE FORMAT

The format for this course will be lecture-style presentations and case study analysis with audience discussion and participation.
