Conference Goal

The goal of this training is to strengthen the capacity of community healthcare providers by offering practical guidelines for screening and treating individuals with TB infection.

Conference Objectives

Describe the current epidemiology of TB; list the groups of people who are more likely to be exposed to or infected with *Mycobacterium tuberculosis (Mtb)*; list risk factors for progression to TB disease if infected with *Mtb*; describe the tools used in testing for TB infection; discuss U.S. Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF) recommendations; identify gaps in access to care that impact TB prevention; discuss social and legal impediments to care; discuss the role stigma plays in accessing health care; list considerations in determining treatment candidates; identify and Implement treatment regimens used to treat TB infection; discuss opportunities to collaborate with the health department.
